

Family Learning Programme across Neighbourhood Areas - Spring Term 2011

What we can offer

We will aim to provide at least 1 Family Learning Course, at any one time, in each of the Neighbourhood Areas. All courses will be delivered by qualified, experienced Family Learning Teachers.

We can also fund childcare and bring in childcare staff, provided that the venue can provide facilities which satisfy minimum Health and Safety standards for childcare.

Alternatively, we can arrange for the childcare to be provided in a school nursery under the supervision of qualified crèche staff.

How it will work

At the beginning of each term, schools will be provided with a leaflet, like this, with all the information they need to signpost parents to a range of Family Learning provision within their local neighbourhood and across the city.

Hubs for Family Learning in Neighbourhood Areas

Opposite, are the details of those venues which have been agreed and the Family Learning provision planned for them during Spring 2011.

Hub venues will be reviewed annually and new venues may replace some from the previous year. We plan to allow other schools to have a chance to host provision each year.
