PARENTAL CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARDS ACTIVITIES IN SCHOOL.

As part of the curriculum class groups will take part in various activities including food technology, and independence in the community. On some occasions class groups will take part in trips out for the day. To help provide these activities class groups maintain a small fund and we ask parents for a contribution. Class teachers will write to you asking for a weekly contribution to help pay for, cooking activities and to provide students with snacks to support the development of independent living skills.

When groups are going out either using public transport or the school minibus for longer trips either half a day or a full day class teachers will write and ask for a contribution towards the cost of the activity.

The school also operates a school tuck shop. It can provide a useful opportunity to develop skills in using money. From September it will be stocking a range of healthy food options.

If you wish you can send an appropriate amount of money for your child to spend on a daily basis.

When sending money into school can you ensure it is in either, an envelope, or other type of container, clearly marked with the pupil's name and the amount and stating how much is intended for the tuck shop, as a contribution to the class fund or for any additional purpose.
